The Foot & Ankle Center Frisco is proud to introduce to you a new revolutionary treatment that is taking the medical community by storm. A new era of regenerative medicine has taken off over the past few years. Regenerative medicine is the idea of giving the body the materials it needs to rebuild damaged tissue. Whether it is damage cartilage and arthritis, inflamed/torn ligament, tendon, nerve or even trauma created by surgical intervention, regenerative medicine creates an environment that allows the body to repair the damaged tissue.

Clarix® is Cryo-Preserved Umbilical Cord and Amniotic Membrane. The powder form is injected in the office and the sheet form has been used to lay over surgical sites in the operating room. By injecting or laying these grafts inside a damaged area of the body we create an environment full of growth factors and anti-inflammatory properties typically not seen outside of the placenta. These growth factors recruit your own stem cells to repair the damaged tissue with minimal scar tissue formation.

At the Foot & Ankle Center of Frisco we have been using these grafts in the office and in surgery with great success. Our surgical patients have less pain and swelling after surgery. In the office we inject the powder form into areas that have not responded to traditional treatments often preventing these patients from needing surgery. Studies published on these Amniotic Stem cell treatments have shown a significant decrease in pain and improved functional recovery. There are no apparent short or longer term side effects and they are indicated for a variety of different conditions. See below for a list of conditions that may benefit from these grafts.
